Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree (100 seats) granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur, Kerala in respect of students being trained at Karuna Medical College, Palakkad, Kerala was carried out by the Council's Assessors on 14th November, 2019. The compliance verification assessment report (14th November, 2019) alongwith the summary/observations of the member of the UG Expert Group was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided to revoke the decision of application of clause 8(3)(1)(c) of Establishment of Medical College Regulation (Amendment) Part II dated 16th April, 2010 and amended on 18.3.2016.

The Board of Governors further decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur, Kerala in respect of students being trained at Karuna Medical College, Palakkad, Kerala be continued restricting the number of admission to 100 (one hundred) students.

The Board of Governors also decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April, 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under-

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8 (3) ...

- (2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- (3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.
- (4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute....."
